# **Zone 5 Limited Classes**

## **Rules:**

#### To be eligible:

- 1. Owner/Exhibitor MUST reside in Zone 5.
- 2. Horse or Exhibitor must **not** have placed in the top 5 at the World Show for those specific classes in the **past 3 years (2020-2021-2022)**.
- 3. Horse or Exhibitor must **not** have place in the Top 5 Honor Roll for that specific class in the **past 3 years** (2020-2021-2022).
- 4. Amateur & Youth must meet APHA ownership rules.
- 5. WT Classes do not effect eligibility.
- Exhibitors who have won a Zone 5 Limited class the past 2 times the class has been held are
  ineligible to compete in that event; however, can compete in the other events. See chart below for
  those class winners.

**Entry Fee:** \$20 if entered in the corresponding APHA class entry fee will be \$10

# Novice Non Pro=exhibitor that has a current Novice Amateur, Novice Youth APHA card for that class, or Amateur Walk Trot APHA Card that denotes Novice Showmanship Eligibility.

@ Non Pro Walk Trot=exhibitor that has a current APHA card and shows in the Youth Walk Trot (5-10) or has a current APHA Amateur Walk-Trot card

# 2023 Eligibility Determination for the Zone 5 Limited Classes

Eligibility is determined on a each type of event meaning you have to follow this 4 times (Showmanship, Hunter Under Saddle, Western Pleasure, Horsemanship).

For example, if you are not eligible for showmanship that applies to all showmanship classes. However, you maybe be eligible for HUS, WP, or HMS.

Follow and answer the questions for each event type to determine eligibility.
